

ORDER

On March 2, the Crawford Family Farm Partnership, Relator, filed a petition for writ of mandamus, along with a motion for temporary relief requesting that this Court grant temporary injunctive relief preventing TransCanada Keystone Pipeline, L.P., from (a) entering on its land, and (b) performing any and all on-site activities that disturb the surface or subsurface of the land.

After reviewing the petition and the motion for temporary relief, this Court is of the opinion that the temporary relief requested should be granted and all activities stayed pending the ruling of this Court on the petition, in accordance with and under the restrictions of the temporary restraining order previously issued in this case.

Now, therefore, it is ordered that TransCanada Keystone Pipeline, L.P., is restrained from entering on the Crawford Family Farm Partnership land and from performing any and all on-site activities that disturb the surface or subsurface of the land, pending this Court's determination of the petition for writ of mandamus or further order from this Court.

It is further ordered that the real party in interest, TransCanada Keystone Pipeline, L.P., shall file a response to the petition for writ of mandamus, to be received by this Court within five days of the date of this order.

This Court anticipates a prompt resolution to this matter.
